Project Description

Create adorable Valentine lollipop holders with personalized messages using the mySewnet software. This beginner-friendly project includes step-by-step instructions for designing, stitching, and assembling heart-shaped felt holders, perfect for gifting sweet treats on Valentine's Day!

Project Material

- Small Metal Hoop 100 x 100
- Tear a way Stabilizer
- Felt in any color
- Thread to match same color top and bottom.
- mySewnet™ embroidery Software


Project Instructions

- 1. Open mySewnet Software
- 2. Choose Blank Canvas
- 3. Set Hoop size to 100 x 100 Metal Hoop
- 4. Choose the SuperDesigns Tab
 - a. Type "Heart" into the Search and hit the enter key. All embroideries that have a heart will show up in the superdesign window.
 - b. Left click on the down arrow at the lower right of the window to drop the window down and see all designs.





- 5. Left click to choose a design,
 - a. Set Size to 90
 - b. Click Apply



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- 6. Click the Letter tab
- 7. Choose a font (we used Arial for our design), font size will depend upon font chosen we set our font size to 14 mm
 - a. Don't forget you can edit Letter Properties once the saying is applied in the hoop.
- 8. Type in LOVE and click Apply
- 9. Type in BUG and click Apply



10. Move and rotate your lettering to fit within the design



- 11. There are several tools to help you rotate.
 - a. On the home tab you can use Rotate 45
 - b. When you left click and select the letter, the circle tool on the right hand side of the box will allow you to rotate the design.
 - c. On the home tab, choose Modify Design and you can type in a specific degree of rotation.

Note: On this design, we used the circle tool to move the design to an appropriate rotation and then used the Modify Design to fine tune the degree of rotation. To make the second rotation match, we left clicked the design to choose it and then opened the Modify Design tool and typed in the same degree of rotation.



- 12. In the filmstrip choose all the lettering by holding down the control key and left clicking each line of lettering.
- 13. Right click and choose Group or on the Home tab left click the Group button.
- 14. Left click on the lettering group and move it up to the top of the filmstrip, so that it will stitch out first.
 - a. Be sure to leave room in the middle for the lollipop.


How to place the eyelets to secure the lollipop.

15. On the Frame tab, left click Motif Underline



- 16. Choose Select Motif
- 17. Choose Group Husqvarna Viking
- 18. Choose Category A Utility Stitches
- 19. Choose Stitch number 34
- 20. Click Ok
 - a. Set Repeats to 1
 - b. Uncheck Group
 - c. Click "Apply"

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- 21. Duplicate eyelet for a total of two (2) eyelets.
 - a. Space eyelets about 1" apart at a 45 degree angle.
 - b. To help with spacing Click on the view tab
- 22. Under grid Click Show Grid
 - a. In size type in .5" and click the tab key to make your grid one half an inch squares Use your grid to space your eyelets.
- 23. To use the measurement tool, click Get Length, left click at your starting point and keep the left click pressed down as you drag the cursor to the end point.
 - a. The program with give you the length in inches and millimeters. Right click to turn off the measurement tool.



Stitching - Materials

- 24. Hoop tear a way and top layer of felt in hoop.
- 25. Begin to Stitch out lettering
- 26. Remove hoop and pin bottom layer of felt



- 27. Stitch remainder of design
 - a. (If you wish to simply the process use one color, hoop all layers at once and stitch the hole design without stopping)
- 28. Remove project from hoop
- 29. Remove tear a way from design



- 30. Trim any threads that need to be trimmed
- 31. Cut around design and puncture eyelets. You can use pinking shears or applique scissors
- 32. Insert lollipop.
